• School Board Trustee - Karen Botsford

- Budget Committee Meeting- good news for funding, if we went with the status quo, then we will have enough money.
- But what was clear that came from all the interest groups is that the status quo is low, and that the budget needs to be enriched.
- Strategic plan is in process; The focus is on inclusivity, equity, outdoor learning, indigenous studies, literacy, numeracy, and student improvements. It will be student focused.
- First Budget Process- difficult to discern what to do. Public Consultation Committee is tomorrow.
- IMC Building was renamed to Siya Centre with a ceremony.
- Four New Day Cares approved: Parkway, Uplands, Giant heads and Wiltse being run by non-profit operators.
- 700 thousand for each year for the next three years- Feeding the Futures Program, in the prevention of hunger, one coordinator for each district.
- Offer and happy to help with May Day.

- Blaine- does the Budget Infrastructure Committee cover safety concerns- our plug outlets are unsafe with just the one prong outlet.
- Karen will take it to the Secretary Treasurer of Maintenance- capital funds that cover infrastructure concerns. Will be adding electrical support with hopefully a full-time electrician.
